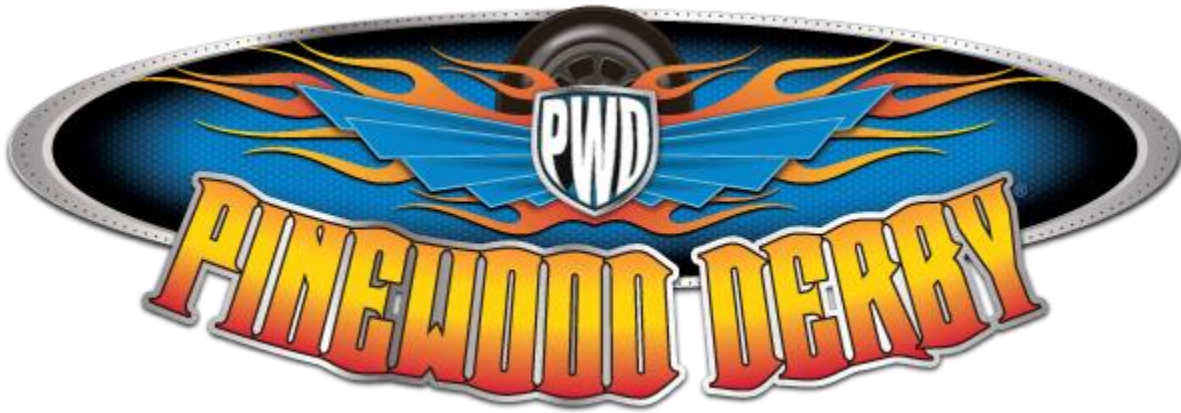

Check-in and inspection of all cars will take place between 9:00 and 10:00, with the race starting for all age groups at 10:15. Once everyone has raced, voting for Most Imaginative and Best in Show Overall will begin. After voting is complete the fastest cars will compete in the Grand Champion Race. Siblings race will be conducted immediately following Scout race. The event will end with trophies being presented as noted on the next page.

Registration: Pre-registration is required to enter the race no later than March 11, 2020; **NO REGISTRATIONS** will be accepted the day of the race.

Entry fee: \$10.00 per scout registered by March 11, 2019. All pack lists with names of all participants including siblings should be submitted to council office by close of business March 11, 2020. Payment will be accepted day of the race.

Please make sure scouts are listed under the correct rank: This helps ensure that scouts are registered for the correct race.

Attached is a pre-registration form that the Cubmaster must complete and return to the council office by March 11, 2019. All registrations must be done as a pack, no individual registrations. Only 3 Lion Scouts, 3 Tiger Scouts, 3 Wolf Scouts, 3 Bear Scouts, and 3 Webelos Scouts per pack are eligible to participate in the district speed race. In addition, each pack can register and 1 scout for Best in Show Overall. Each pack can register a maximum of 16 scouts as previously described. Oconee District Pinewood Derby Rules

Golden Rule: This for fun!! This for fun!! This for fun!!

****Please remind scouts, that the Pinewood Derby is not about the trophy, it is about the family bonding and fellowship with our scouts****

1. Only registered Lion, Tiger, Wolf, Bear, and WEBELOS Scouts are eligible to participate.
2. Car construction shall be as follows:
 - a. Only the Grand Prix type car # 1622 purchased through the BSA is acceptable.
 - b. The Scout must build a new car for each season.
 - c. Only wheels and nails in the kit are permissible. (Official BSA wheels in different colors are also permitted)
 - d. Wheel bearings, washers, bushings, springs, or any other item added to the wheels and axles are not permissible.
 - e. No changing of the wheel is permitted except the filing off of the mold projection on the wheel. No narrowing of the wheels.
 - f. Only powdered lubricants are permitted.
 - g. Width not to exceed 2 ¾".
 - h. Length not to exceed 7".
 - i. Weight not to exceed 5 ounces. Cars will be weighed using grams (5 ounces = 141.7 grams).
 - j. No loose materials of any kind permitted in or taped on the car.
 - k. The car must be freewheeling with no starting device.
 - l. Only one car per participant.
 - m. In order to avoid the bottom of the car dragging, a minimum bottom clearance of 3/8" is needed. Also, the track has an electric finish line which limits the height of the cars to 4".
 - n. The wheel base (distance between the front and rear axle slots) may not be modified. Entrants must use the pre-cut axle slots so that the distance between the axles is the same for all racers. The axle slots must be visible on the bottom of the racer.
 - o. Solid Wood Front required. No part of the car can protrude beyond the start line pegs.
3. Each car must pass inspection by the official inspection team before it will be allowed to compete. The inspectors have the right to disqualify those cars which do not meet the specifications in rule 2.
4. Once a car has passed inspection and has been accepted by the officials, there will be no repairs or modifications performed on the car unless authorized by a race official. **No lubricant will be added after the cars inspection.**
5. Once the race begins, only the race officials and the Scout will be allowed in the racing area.
6. Once a race is underway, if a car leaves its assigned lane, interfering with another car, the heat will be run again.
7. If a car is disabled, the car may be repaired within 5 minutes under the supervision of a race official.
8. **All decisions made by the appointed judges will be final.**
9. All Scouts must have a responsible adult with them for the entire event.
10. Unscoutlike or unsportsmanlike conduct by a participant or member of the audience will be grounds for expulsion from the race and /or the race area.
